2. **expel** (v) - force to leave; to drive out

The boy was expelled from the class for his bad behavior.

3. **exhale** (v) - to breathe out

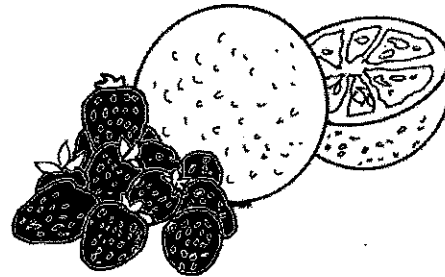
Take a deep breath in and then slowly exhale as you count to ten.

4. **extract** (v) - to pull out or draw out

You can extract the juice from the orange by squeezing it.

5. **exempt** (adj) - to free or excuse from a rule that others follow

When I broke my arm I was exempt from physical education class.

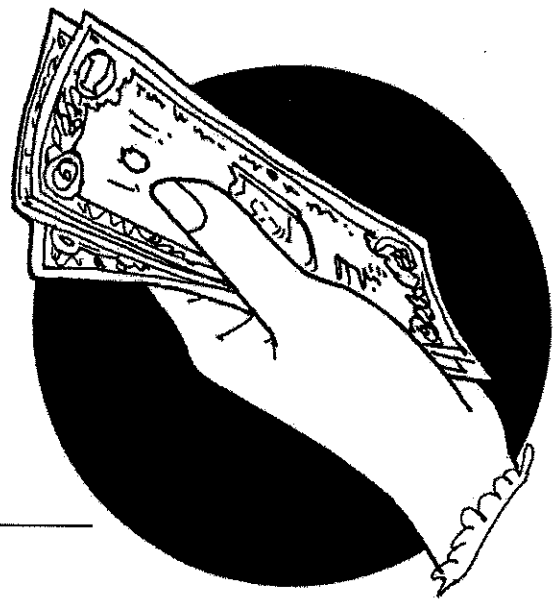
