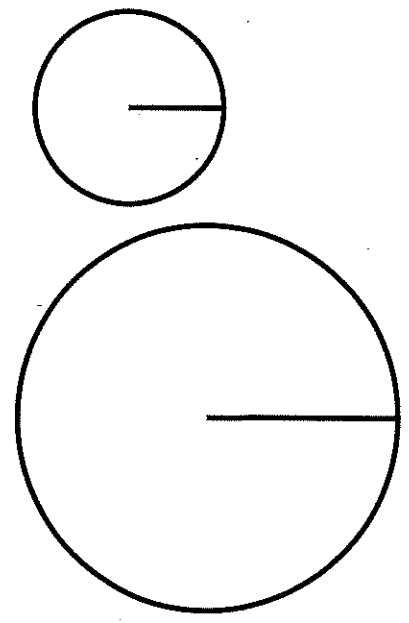

2. <b>circulatory</b> (adj) - going in a circuit, circular	<i>The <u>circulatory</u> system includes the heart, veins, arteries, and capillaries.</i>
3. <b>circumference</b> (n) - the line or distance around the outside of a circle	<i>The <u>circumference</u> of a circle is like the perimeter of a rectangle.</i>
4. <b>circumstance</b> (n) - the condition surrounding or related to an event	<i>The officer noted the <u>circumstances</u> of the traffic accident.</i>
5. <b>circumscribe</b> (v) - to draw a line around	<i>The words "I Love You" were <u>circumscribed</u> by a heart-shape drawing.</i>

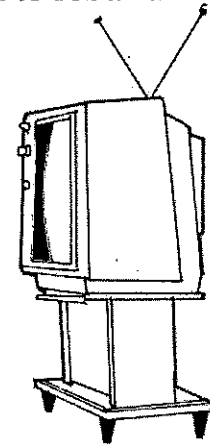
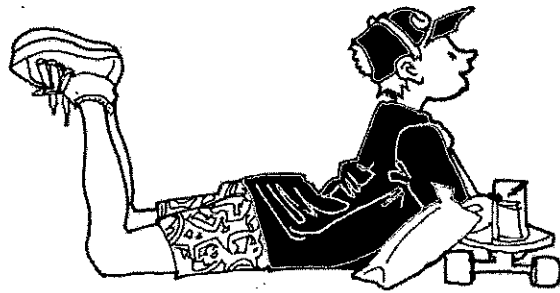

4. <b>regain</b> (v) - to get again, to recover what has been lost	<i>Our class hopes to <u>regain</u> the sportsmanship trophy this month.</i>

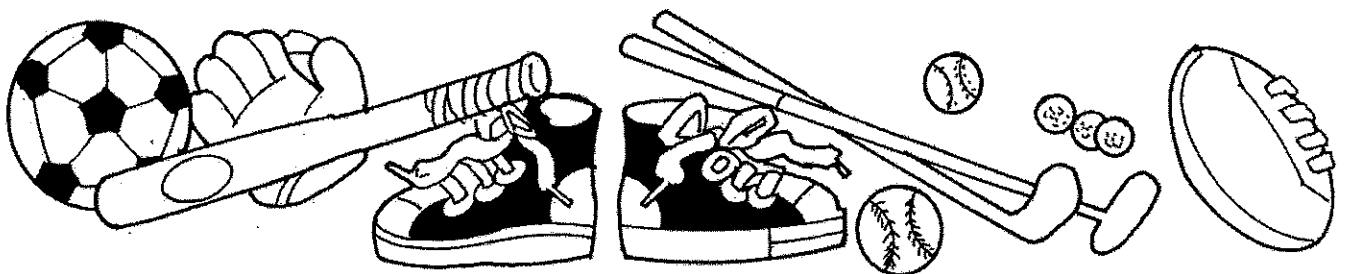

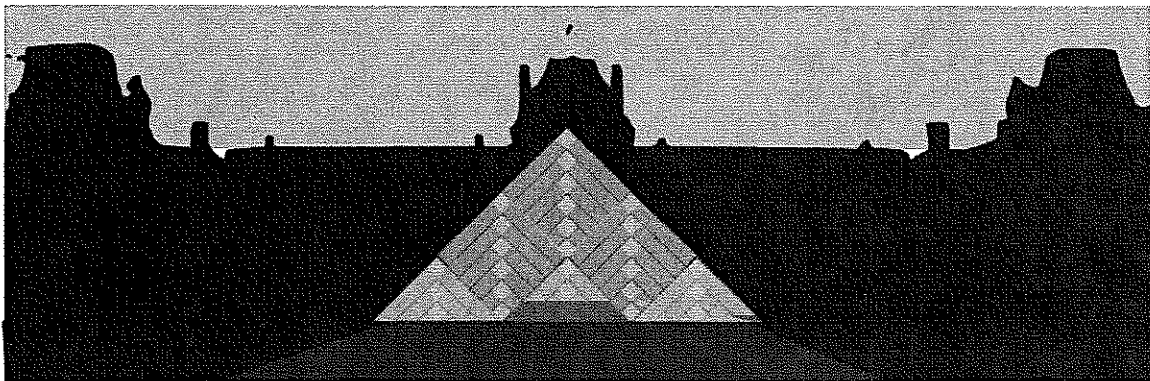
